ORDER

And Whereas the Saroj Nalini Primary Teachers Training Institute, 23/1 Ballygunge, Station Road, Calcutta, West Bengal - 700019 was granted recognition vide order No.ERC/7-18/2001/1500 dated 23.05.2001 for PTT course from the session 2001-2002 with an intake of 40 students for one year course under 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act, 1993 with condition that institution will continue to fulfill norms laid down by NCTE time to time.

And Whereas the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations notified from time to time clearly stated that the Elementary Teacher Education Programme should be of 2 years duration. However, a relaxation in Appendix - V of the Rule given to the states to run year Elementary course till 2004-2005 after which the institution were to switch over to 2 years courses.

And Whereas the matter was discussed in the ERC meeting time to time and notices were issued to the institutions instructing them not to admit students till the compliance of the requirement as per NCTE Regulations.

And Whereas the Eastern Regional Committee in its 95th meeting held on 27th - 29th April, 2009 considered the matter relating to elementary institutions in the state of West Bengal with reference to switching PIT/ETE/D.Ed. course to 2 years duration as per the NCTE regulation. The Committee noted the letter dated 16.04.2009 of West Bengal Board of Primary Education and the Notification No. 1039-SE (Pry) dated 23rd October 2008 to the effect that the Government of West Bengal has switched over to the two year D.Ed. course in place of one year Primary Teacher Training (PTT) course and accordingly appointed the West Bengal Board of Primary Education as the affiliating/ examining body.

Now therefore in exercise of the authority vested and as per the decision of the Eastern Regional Committee the Saroj Nalini Primary Teachers Training Institute, 23/1, Ballygunge, Station Road, Calcutta, West Bengal - 700019 is hereby permitted to admit students and run PTT/ETE/D.Ed. course of 2 years duration from the session 2009-2010 as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the recognition orders issued as per the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations.





ORDER

It appears from the Order bearing No. ERC/7-18/2001/1500 dated 23RD May, 2001 revived by (F No. ERC/WB-E/N-8/2000), ERC/95.9.4/2009/34(4) date 27TH May, 2009, issued by the Regional Director, Eastern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education, that in exercise of the powers vested under Clause (a) of Sub-section 3 of Section 14 of National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee has granted recognition to **Saroj Nalini Primary Teachers' Training Institute, 23/1, Ballygunge Station Road, Calcutta, Pin - 700 019, to admit students and for conducting Primary Teachers' Training (Diploma-in-Education) Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(fifty) students.**

The West Bengal Board of Primary Education, being the Examining Body, appointed vide Gazette Notification of the Order dated 25RD October, 2008 issued by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, School Education Department, Primary Branch, grants affiliation from the ensuing academic session i.e. from 2009-2010 in terms of said Order to **Saroj Nalini Primary Teachers' Training Institute, 23/1, Ballygunge Station Road, Calcutta, Pin-700 019**, without insisting on the submission of the Gazette Notification of the said order dated 27TH May, 2009 of the Regional Director, Eastern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education as already settled by the Hon'ble Justice Aniruddha Bose, Calcutta High Court in his order dated 23RD April, 2009 in W. P. No. 3613 (W) of 2009 with W. P. No. 3083 (W) of 2009, with W. P. No. 5036 (W) of 2009, with W.P. No. 5027 (W) of 2009, W.P. No. 5028 (W) of 2009, W.P. No. 5051 (W) of 2009 and W.P. No. 5052 (W) of 2009.

Fees payable to the Examining Body by the Institute and its students would be intimated by this Office in due course of time.
